- Image of choice or freehand drawing
- Craft knife
- Needle tool
- Toothpick, orange stick, double ended knitting needle or any tool that can be used to smooth and contour clay
- Small tile or piece of plain card

### Afternoon:

Demo: Pat will be giving us a short demo on how to make cardboard gift boxes for your items.

If you would like to make some yourself on the day you will need to bring:

- Ruler
- Card (300gsm preferably)
- Some sort of knife or scalpel to score card
- Glue and some pegs or paper clips

Sue Heaser will be giving an introduction to Polymer Clay for beginners.
